



**SAINT LEO the GREAT**  
(391-461)  
Pope and Doctor of the Church  
Feast day - November 10th

Saint Leo the Great is the first pope doctor of the Church, and one of only two that the title "Great" is given. In addition to writing, leading, and exemplifying a unified doctrine for the church, Leo acted in the role of peacemaker. He met, single-handedly, Attila the Hun, when Attila was marauding through Italy. All peoples and governments were scattering before him. In Rome all the officials left, the people turned toward Leo their pope, asking his help. Attila's troops, hardened veterans seasoned in plunder, were ready and waiting to cross the river Po when Saint Leo, entered the disordered camp and stood before the King of the Huns. The Pope asked Attila to turn back and leave Italy unmolested. It is one of the most dramatic stories of the Church that Attila, "The Terror of the World", yielded before Leo, the Pope. Attila's servants, so the story is told, asked him why he had reversed his custom and capitulated so easily to the Bishop of Rome. The brigand chief answered that all the while the Pope was speaking, he, Attila, was himself consumed in fear, for there had appeared in the air above the Pope a figure of a great man, holding in his hand a drawn sword with which he made as if to kill Attila unless he consented to do as Leo asked. The figure was thought to be that of St. Peter!"
