Corpus Christi Year A helps us think about Jesus as the living bread. The readings show that God feeds His people and stays close to them. Jesus gives Himself to us in the Eucharist. This food brings life and hope. It also reminds us to trust God even in hard times, just as the Israelites did in the desert.

This day also teaches us about unity. When we share the one bread, we become one body in Christ. The Eucharist brings us together and helps us remember what Jesus has done for us. It calls us to stay close to Him and to one another through this great gift.

**First Reading – Deuteronomy 8:2-3, 14b-16a**

Moses reminds the Israelites of God’s forty years in the desert, testing them through hunger and providing manna “a food unknown to you and your fathers” to show that life is not sustained by bread alone, but by every word from God’s mouth. This echoes the Exodus journey, where God fed them miraculously and brought forth water from rock, underscoring divine provision and covenant faithfulness.

**Responsorial Psalm – Psalm 147:12-13, 14-15, 19-20**

Praises God as the one who strengthens Jerusalem’s gates, fills the land with wheat, sends forth His word swiftly, and reveals His statutes to Israel. The psalmist affirms that God’s ways are unique to His people.

**Second Reading – 1 Corinthians 10:16-17**

Paul explains that the bread and cup are “a participation in the body and blood of Christ,” uniting believers as one body through the one loaf. This passage grounds the Eucharist in the mystery of Christ’s presence and the unity of the Church.

**Prayer for the Day:**

*O Lord, You feed us with the bread of heaven. May we always be nourished by Your presence in the Eucharist, and may we live as one body in Christ, united in love and service to You.*
